## ORDINANCE NO. 2006 - 001

# AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF GALLATIN COUNTY REGIONAL PARK RULE PROHIBITING UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY

1. **RECITALS.** WHEREAS, Gallatin County purchased approximately 100 deeded acres described as Tract 3A of Certificate Survey No. 2202A, located in Section 3, Township 2 South, Range 5 East, P.M.M, for the purpose of providing parks and recreation; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2004, the Gallatin County Commissioners pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. § 7-16-2301 *et. seq.*, created a Board of Park Commissioners (Resolution No. 2004-130); and

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. § 7-16-2322(2) provides that the Gallatin County Commission may adopt an ordinance in substantial compliance with the provisions of § 7-5-103 through § 7-5-107 to establish criminal offenses and penalties for violations of park rules as provided in § 7-5-109.

- 2. <u>APPLICABILITY</u>. This Ordinance shall apply to the Gallatin County Regional Park (Tract 3A of Certificate Survey No. 2202A, located in Section 3, Township 2 South, Range 5 East) located in Gallatin County.
- 3. <u>UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY PROHIBITED</u>. It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Ordinance for any person to enter in or upon the Gallatin County Regional Park without written authorization from a duly appointed Gallatin County Park Warden.
- 4. **PENALTY**. Violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine up to \$500.00 and/or imprisonment of up to six (6) months in the County jail.

The Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder shall post a copy of this ordinance and shall make copies available to the public upon 1<sup>st</sup> Reading and Approval of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its 2nd Reading and Approval.
