MONFORTON SCHOOL DISTRICT 27
BUILDING RESERVE LEVY

Shall the Trustees of Monforton School District 27 be authorized to impose a building reserve levy in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) per year for ten (10) years and being approximately 2.57 mills, for a total of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) for the purpose of light replacement, window replacement, code improvements, facility modification, construction, repairs, alterations, and equipping the buildings? Passage of this proposal will result in an annual tax of approximately \$5.11 on a home with assessed market value of \$100,000 and approximately \$10.22 on a home with assessed market value of \$200,000.

MONFORTON SCHOOL DIST 27
GENERAL FUND BUDGET AUTHORITY
AND LEVY

Shall the district be authorized to impose an increase in local taxes to support the general fund in the amount of \$ 13,442.01 (Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Two Dollars and 01/100) which is approximately (1.72) mills for the purpose of operating and maintaining the Monforton School. Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$3.42 (Three Dollars and Forty-Two Cents) and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$6.83 (Six Dollars and Eighty-Three Cents). The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the district levies that amount each year thereafter. However, lowering over-BASE tax levies in any year will lower the amount of permissively over-BASE levies in subsequent years.

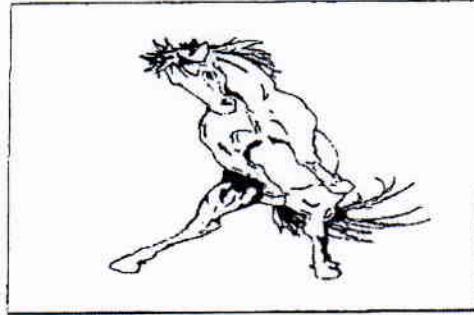
