**A REFERENDUM ON AMENDING THE BOZEMAN CITY
CHARTER TO ADD TWO MEMBERS TO THE CITY
COMMISSION**

The 2006 Bozeman City Charter requires City of Bozeman Voters to decide at this election whether to amend the Charter to increase the number of city commissioners from the current four commissioners plus the mayor to six plus the mayor. To increase the number of commissioners, the voters must decide whether to amend Section 2.02 (c) (Composition) of the Charter. If the voters choose to amend the Charter, the two additional commissioners will be elected at the General Election in November, 2011 with a four year to begin at the first commission meeting in January 2012.
