



<b>CLASS</b>	I	<p><b>Description:</b> Route will be a long term connection between the Four Corners area and the Gallatin Regional Park. The route will follow existing trail systems in subdivisions like Parklands and Black Bull on the trail's western boundary and Oak Springs on its eastern end.</p> <p>The trail corridor has to be broad at this time due to large tracts of land in single-ownership in the area. When and if these properties are subdivided, trail segments will be included as part of the subdivision process. Other segments will require work by the County and other interested parties to negotiate with private landowners for trail easements or utilize road rights of way.</p> <p>Trail is intended to be a recreational, natural fines path and will not be plowed in the winter.</p>
