Mini Grants may be used for:

- Education or Training
- Equipment
- Project or Activity for Consumers
- Implementation and Facilitation of new or existing programs
- Innovations to improve mental health services

Grants are typically awarded for up to \$300.

New applications are to be submitted to the MHLAC Mini Grant Committee by the first of each month. Response letters will be sent out within 30 days from receipt of application notifying whether the application has been accepted, denied or more information requested. Please assist in the application process by thoroughly filling out all questions.

Successful recipients will be asked to make a press release to announce their project or activity to the public, along with a brief presentation to the MHLAC upon completion of their project.
