An increase in property taxes may lead to an increase in rental costs.</p>

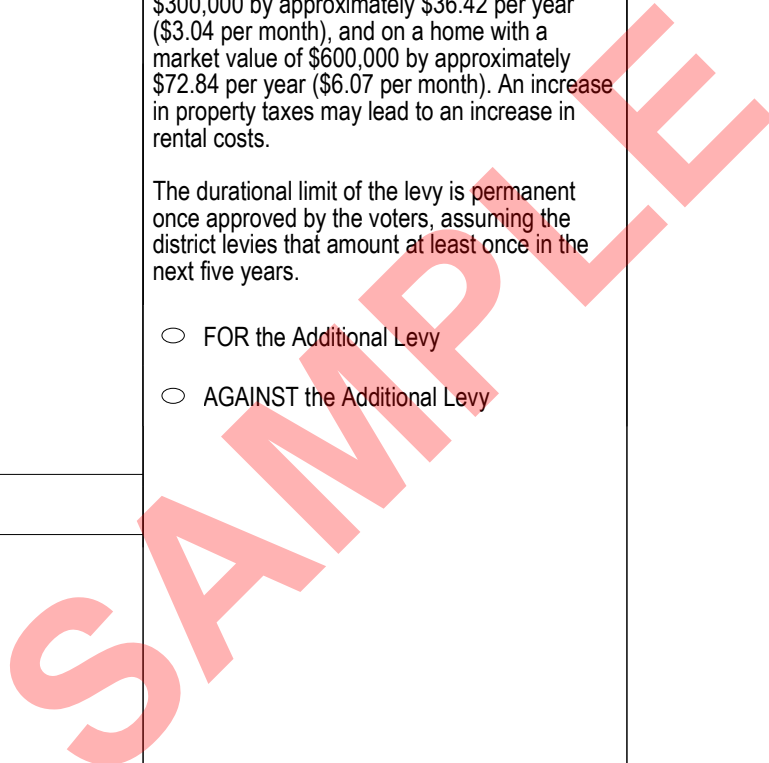
